## TRAINING

Troopers receive 23 weeks of rigorous training at the Kansas Highway Patrol Training Academy in Salina, Kansas. Experienced instructors and coaches lead the recruits through an extensive curriculum of basic and advanced law enforcement courses, including an intense fitness regimen. Upon graduation from the Training Academy, recruits undergo 16 weeks of field training with a veteran trooper.
